Dr Joshua McCarroll is a 2011 Cure Cancer Australia grant recipient and has dedicated his life to finding a cure by specialising in brain cancer research. Few young researchers have as much motivation to fight cancer as passionately as Joshua. As a young child, he was diagnosed with cancer and had to undergo two years of chemotherapy and radiation.

Joshua survived his childhood cancer and says “If my diagnosis had been made five years prior, my treatment wouldn’t have been discovered yet and I would have lost my battle. Now I am determined to help find new treatments to help save others.”

Advanced brain cancer is a terrible disease with few treatment options. With his Cure Cancer Australia grant, Joshua hopes to use nanotechnology to target chemotherapy drugs directly to brain cancer cells and at the same time reduce harmful side effects.
