Children's Cancer Institute Australia (CCIA) was founded more than three decades ago by two passionate fathers. They each had a child diagnosed with

leukaemia and knew not enough was being done to fight this deadly disease. At that time, of the hundreds of children diagnosed with cancer barely half were being cured with the treatments available.

CCIA is the only independent medical research institute focused on finding cures and improving treatments for childhood cancer in Australia. causes to adult cancer and occurs in different forms to adult cancers. In addition, large pharmaceutical companies focus their research on drug discoveries for the larger adult cancer market with no investment in research of childhood cancers.

Today CCIA is internationally recognised as a leader in childhood cancer research, in particular as a global leader in "translational research" which means our discoveries at the bench are taken to the bedside of paediatric oncology units as quickly as possible.

But even though there have been great advances in survival rates, there are still too many children suffering with this terrible disease, with your help we really can change that – **we don't need a miracle, just the funds to make it happen.** 

#### OUR FUNDRAISING GOALS

Hearing the words "your child has cancer" is something no parent should ever have to hear. With your commitment, Endure for a Cure 12 hour bike ride aims to raise funds to expand CCIA's research into finding cures and improving treatments for children with cancer.

I will never forget the moment when the doctor walked in the room and said Luciano had neuroblastoma. The only things I remember in his explanation were the words "tumour" and "cancer". I was told his chances of survival were 50%



### HOW YOUR FUNDRAISING HELPS:

Every single dollar raised will make a significant difference by helping to fund our life saving research, examples of the difference your funds will make:

# \$130

will cover the cost of testing one child's risk of relapse with leukaemia so their treatment can be tailored accordingly.

### \$500

will provide six months' supply of antibody to detect abnormal proteins in tumours to help us discover potential new drugs.

## \$2,600

will cover all costs in the development of the initial Minimal Residual Disease (MRD) test for one child with acute lymphoblastic leukemia.

# \$10,000

will provide a high powered microscope to visualise the effects of drug treatment on cancer cells.
