- Walk among the clouds – take a skywalk 30 metres above virgin rainforest canopy.
- Watch the sun rise after trekking to the lofty heights of Mount Kinabalu.
- Enjoy the colourful Malay culture with a city tour to local museums, temples and mosques.
- View stalactites as you swim through the impressive Clearwater Caves and travel by longboat on a river cruise.

What is this adventure?

Immerse yourself in one of the oldest, most beautiful and diverse rainforests in the world and see why Borneo has captured the imagination of nature enthusiasts for centuries.

Borneo is home to jungles teeming with wildlife, flowing rivers, and the incredible Mount Kinabalu and Mulu National Park, one of the region's largest. Expect to see orangutans and the proboscis monkey, hundreds of varieties of birds, thousands of orchids and millions of bats flying overhead at dusk at the entrance of beautiful Deer Cave. Challenge yourself as you trek to the summit of Mount Kinabalu and the Pinnacles Trail, and experience traditional culture and hospitality in an overnight stay at an Iban longhouse. In bearing witness to the beauty of Borneo, you will gain a better sense of the tragedy of the deforestation that is occurring at a rapid rate in other parts of the region. The funds you raise will assist Greenpeace to take direct peaceful action to expose these and other global environmental problems.

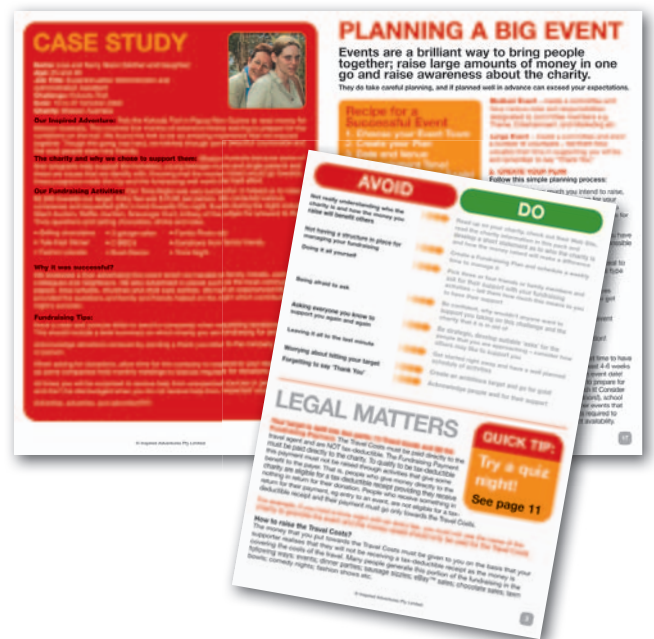
In the Fundraising Toolkit you will find plenty of ideas, case studies, practical ways of doing things and plenty of inspiration!

Trip Notes

The travel for this adventure will be operated by Flight Centre.

Day 1, Saturday 29th September Depart Australia

Your adventure begins! Depart Australia for Kota Kinabalu in Malaysia. On arrival you will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2, Sunday 30th September Kota Kinabalu city tour and welcome dinner

This morning you will get to know Kota Kinabalu, the capital of Sabah, on a city tour. Visit the Sabah Foundation Building, the tallest tower in Sabah and one of the few hanging structures in the world and the Sabah State Museum where exhibits reflect the diversity of Sabah's culture and trace early trade links with the neighbouring countries. After admiring the Sabah State Mosque, a masterpiece of architecture with its dove-grey walls and glittering majestic domes, we head to Tanjung Aru, famous for its 2km-long sandy beach. Return to your hotel for some free time then head out to a fun local restaurant for a welcome dinner.

Meals: B, D

Day 3, Monday 1st October Kinabalu National Park – Summit Trail

This morning we head to the World Heritage-listed Kinabalu National Park, home to Mount Kinabalu, Malaysia's highest peak. The summit climb is sure to be a highlight of your trip, despite being steep in parts. You will carry only an overnight bag but may wish to hire a porter to assist you. Kinabalu National Park is a nature-lover's dream and as you walk, your mountain guide will point out some of 1,000 species of orchids, as well as rhododendrons and the carnivorous pitcher plants. The walk will take 4-6 hours and we'll stop to enjoy a packed lunch en route. Tonight we stay in Laban Rata in basic dormitory accommodation, and enjoy a simple meal and an early night, ready for the final climb the next day.

Day 4, Tuesday 2nd October Mount Kinabalu

We wake early, at around 2.30am, and eat a light supper before starting the climb to the Mount Kinabalu summit. The climb is challenging in parts, but when you arrive at the top in time to see the sun rise over the jungles of Borneo and the South China Sea, it will all be worth it. We spend some time catching our breath and enjoying that 'top of the world' feeling before returning to Laban Rata for breakfast, then back to our starting point. From here we head to nearby Mount Kinabalu Heritage Hotel, where we stay overnight.

Meals: B, L, D



Day 5, Wednesday 3rd October Sukau River Lodge

Today we head to the Sandakan region and Sukau River Lodge, stopping at the Gomantong Caves en route. The caves are home to over a million bats, and the edible bird's nest that is popular throughout Asia. The area surrounding the cave is a nature reserve, which is home to abundant birdlife including crested serpent eagles, kingfishers, Asian fairy bluebirds and leaf birds – as well as wild orangutans. We continue on, following the course of the Kinabatangan River, home to possibly the greatest concentration of wildlife in Borneo. After checking in at Sukau River Lodge, take an afternoon river cruise in search of wildlife such as macaques, red and silver leaf monkeys, crocodiles, civet cats, snakes, wild boar, orangutans and proboscis monkeys, found only in Borneo.

Meals: B, L, D

Day 6, Thursday 4th October Oxbow Lakes, nature trail and river cruise

Enjoy an early morning boat trip to the Oxbow Lakes, a chance to spot more wildlife. Expect to see birds of all shapes and forms, including egrets, kingfishers, oriental darters, bee-eaters and hornbills. Freshwater fish are in abundance and you may also see otters and sometimes even wild elephants. Embark on a trek through the rainforest, before returning to the lodge for lunch. This afternoon you may choose to put your feet up and relax or take another afternoon river cruise – it's up to you.

Meals: B, L, D

Day 7, Friday 5th October Sepilok Orangutan Centre, Kota Kinabalu

After breakfast, we leave Sukau River Lodge and drive to the famous Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre. Founded in 1964, the centre helps captive orangutans learn to climb and fend for themselves in the wild with the hope that one day they may return to the forest. You will have the chance to view these beautiful creatures up-close as they return to feed. After lunch, you transfer to Sandakan Airport for your flight to Kota Kinabalu.

Day 8, Saturday 6th October Mulu National Park, Royal Mulu Resort

This morning we fly to Sarawak and Mulu National Park. Covering a staggering 544 km² of virgin rainforest by fast-flowing rivers, it is the largest park in the region and one of the most spectacular in all of Asia. Your expert jungle guide will be on hand to help you appreciate the incredible biodiversity of the rainforest here, introducing you to some of the 8,000 species of flowering plants, 200 mammals, 100 butterfly species and at least 450 different kinds of birds, including the hornbill with its distinctive curly beak. After lunch we see the rainforest from above on a canopy sky walk, then hike through the peat swamp forest on a 3km plank walk to Deer Cave, one of a number of caves that make up one of the world's largest limestone cave systems. We will also visit nearby Lang Cave, which is smaller but features impressive rock formations. At dusk, watch as millions of bats emerge from the caves for their nightly feed – a truly spectacular sight.

Meals: B, L, D

Day 9, Sunday 7th October Clearwater & Wind Caves, Camp 5

This morning we depart the resort by traditional longboat for Clearwater & Wind Caves, home to Asia's longest underground river. A guided forest walk brings you to Wind Cave, which features some impressive stalactites



and stalagmites, best viewed in the illuminated area called 'King's Room'. Continue by longboat to the Clearwater Cave, with its pristine subterranean river and colourful butterflies. After another hour in the longboat you will disembark and take a 3km trek through the jungle to Camp 5, where we will stay in simple dormitory accommodation for the night.

Meals: B, L, D

Day 10, Monday 8th October Pinnacles Summit Trek, Camp 5

Today, we rise early to trek to the summit of the Mulu Pinnacles Trail (1,175m), a challenging but extremely rewarding climb that should take 3-4 hours if you are physically fit. Along the way, you'll see carnivorous pitcher plants and orchids and at the top, you'll be greeted by the breathtaking view of the limestone pinnacles. Spend some time soaking up the view before descending to Camp 5. Alternatively you may choose to trek along the Headhunter's Trail to Melinau Gorge, or spend the day relaxing the camp.

Meals: B, L, D

Day 11, Tuesday 9th October Kuala Terikan, Iban Longhouse

After breakfast, we begin our 11km trek to Kuala Terikan, which should take around 4 hours. From there we continue downriver by longboat to our overnight stay at an Iban longhouse. On arrival, the longhouse chief will welcome you and take you for a tour of his home. Tonight you will experience the culture of the Iban and be treated to their warm hospitality, traditional food and rice wine. We stay with a family in their longhouse. This is a very traditional and authentic experience – the sleeping and bathing arrangements are basic but it's a great experience that will give you a real sense of how the Iban live.

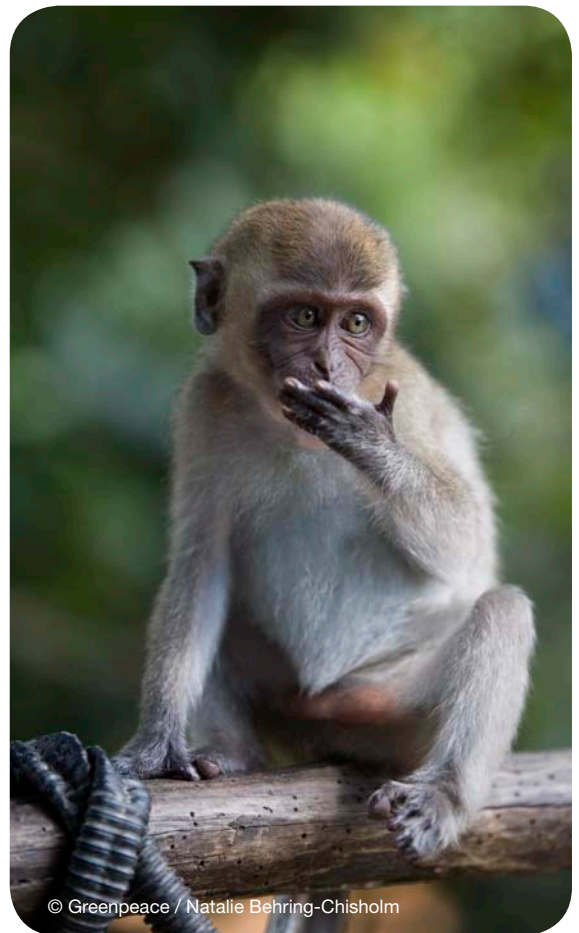

Day 12, Wednesday 10th October Limbang & Departure

Say farewell to your Iban hosts and travel by longboat and van to Limbang. Enjoy a final lunch together in Limbang town before transferring to the airport for your flight home.

Day 13, Thursday 11th October Arrival

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I really do this?

YES, you can! Fundraising and fitness training sound intimidating, but we're here to help you the whole way through. We'll call you regularly with advice, ideas, and encouragement along the way. You're not in this alone – you'll be joined by other people all raising money for this wonderful cause and training for an epic adventure that you'll remember forever.

How do I fundraise?

Past participants have successfully fundraised in many creative and fun ways. We will send you a comprehensive Fundraising Toolkit upon registration to help you reach your target. You will also have regular support from our Inspired Team, who will help you develop and manage your fundraising plan, as well as support from the charity for which you are fundraising.

What does it cost?

Upon registration, you pay a registration fee of \$700. The travel cost and donation to Greenpeace Australia Pacific can be fundraised with the support of Inspired Adventures.

Is my donation tax deductible?

The funds raised for the charity are tax deductible (conditions apply). Funds raised to cover travel costs are not tax deductible.

What's included?

Return international flights with Malaysia Airlines departing from Sydney, Melbourne and Brisbane including taxes, all transport and sightseeing as per itinerary, meals as per itinerary, twin-share accommodation in dormitory lodges, longhouse and 2 star hotels, mountain guide, climbing permit, mountain climbing insurance, entrance fees, carbon-offset, English-speaking guide and Inspired Adventures Team Escort.

What's not included?

Travel insurance, visa fees, personal spending money, personal equipment such as backpack and sleeping bag, personal porters and tips.

How fit do I need to be?

This trek is ranked 4/5. This trip involves trekking or climbing in remote areas in variable weather conditions for up to eight hours a day (possibly more depending on weather conditions and altitude) for four or more days. This includes spending successive days at altitudes up to 4,000m.

Our adventures are specifically designed for people who are relatively fit and willing to train. While no mountaineering experience is required, a good level of physical fitness is essential.

Can I extend my stay?

Of course, many of our participants decide to extend their stay to get the most from their overseas adventure! (Additional travel arrangements are at your own cost).

What is the general age range of participants?

The minimum age is 16 years old accompanied by an adult. We have had participants of all ages from 18–70 years, all united by their sense of adventure.

Will I get a chance to meet other people before we go?

Yes, we will organise a get-together evening for everyone (geography permitting). There will be regular email, phone communications, and a Facebook online community leading up to the trip.

How do I register?

This Inspired Adventure is operated by Flight Centre Ltd.

Please read carefully the terms in the conditions of contract in completing and submitting the Booking Form, you agree to be bound by these conditions which constitute the agreement between Inspired Adventures, Flight Centre Ltd (Flight Centre) and you. The conditions apply to the exclusion of any other terms or conditions unless they are set out in the Booking Form, or are otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties. Previous dealing with the parties will not vary these conditions. No purported variation of these conditions will be effective unless in writing and signed by a person so authorised by Inspired Adventures and Flight Centre.

1. How to Book: To participate in this Inspired Adventure, you must pay a non-refundable registration fee of AUD\$700 including GST payable to Inspired Adventures. Six weeks later you must pay a non-refundable travel deposit of AUD\$400 including GST which must be made payable to Flight Centre. If you register within 4 months of the departure date you must pay the travel deposit of AUD\$400 immediately upon registration.

2. Payments and Fundraising: Eligibility to take part in this Challenge is contingent upon you raising the minimum Fundraising Target. Flight Centre will not accept receipt of your balance payment until there is evidence that your Fundraising Deposit of AUD\$1,000 has been met 20 weeks prior to your departure. The balance of your Fundraising Payments must be made no later than 4 weeks prior to your departure. Travel costs are based on arrangements departing from the published departure city/cities in Australia and exclude travel insurance & visa fees. Flight Centre may be able to arrange travel from other cities in Australia, a surcharge will apply. Registered participants will be required to cover additional travel or accommodation costs required as a result of departing from an alternative destination. Failure to lodge the fundraising target on or before the required date will render you ineligible to depart on the Challenge and you will forfeit in full the AUD\$700 registration fee paid to Inspired Adventures, the AUD\$400 travel cost deposit paid to Flight Centre, and your place on the adventure. Prices:

All prices are subject to availability and can be withdrawn or varied without notice. The price is only guaranteed when paid in full. Please note that prices quoted here are subject to change and will be re quoted at the time of full payment. Price changes may occur by reason of matters outside our control which increase the cost of the product or service. Such factors include adverse currency fluctuations, fuel surcharges, taxes and airfare increases. Please contact your Consultant for up to date prices.

Refunds, Changes and Cancellation Fees:

We are unable to provide a refund to you until we receive the funds from the relevant supplier. Cancelled bookings will incur charges. These charges can be up to 100% of the cost of the booking, regardless of whether travel has commenced. Fees and extra charges will apply where a booking is changed. Fees and extra charges will also apply when tickets or documents are re-issued. Where we incur any liability for a cancellation fee or charge for any booking which you cancel, you agree to indemnify us for the amount of that fee or charge.

Some of the specific terms which apply if you cancel a tour or change your booking are as follows:

Cancellation Fees: If you wish to cancel your tour the following conditions apply:

- Your \$400 travel deposit which is non refundable and non transferable will be forfeited;
- A \$550 cancellation fee will be payable if cancellation occurs between 90-60 days prior to departure; and
