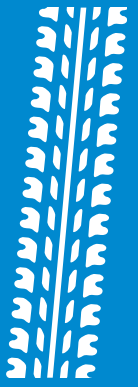

Scope proudly partners with Ability First Australia to run Walk With Me, in Melbourne, Bendigo and Geelong. Other walks take place nationally during September.

Commenced in 2010 Walk With Me is a public participation event conducted nationally. The aim is to raise awareness and celebrate inclusion and the achievements of people with a disability, as well as raising much needed funds.

It is not a fun run, nor a competitive fitness event but a recreational 2km or 4km walk, providing family, friends, colleagues and members of the general public with the opportunity to walk along side people with a disability in a non competitive, lively, fun and very public environment.

In 2012 Walk With Me will expand to include a third walk in Bendigo. Walk With Me in Victoria will be incorporated in to the celebration of our returning Paralympians. This is a result of a recent partnership with the Victorian Institute of Sport.

Each event has been designed to engage and entertain everyone that attends; in addition to the walk there will be everything from face painting to interviews of paralympians. The objectives remain the same:
